



Getting Started with Internet Banking

1. Go to <http://www.texasfirstbank.com> to view the **Internet Banking Login** section on the right side of the page. Choose your Banking Center from the drop down menu then click Login.
2. Type in your Login ID and check the **First Time User** box then click the **Log In** button.
Note: Your login ID is typically your account number.
3. You will be asked to get a Secure Access code to verify your identity as the account holder. The website will let you choose between the phone number and email address given on the enrollment form for delivery of the secure code. Make your selection then click **Continue**. On the following page, type in the code and click **Continue**.
4. You will then be presented with a legal disclosure. Please read and then click **I Accept** to continue. You will then fill out your personal information and click **Create Profile**.
5. Next, you will be asked to create your password. Type your password in the **New Password** box and repeat the password in the **Confirm Password** box. Click on **Submit Password Change** to finish.
6. Now you're ready to bank online! The next time you login, you may have to get another secure access code for your browser registration. This will allow the site to recognize your computer on future visits and avoid asking you to get a Secure Access code.

We may use standard software to collect non-identifying information about or visitors, such as: Date and time our site was accessed; IP address (A numeric address given to servers connected to the Internet); Web browser used; City, State, and Country. Visitors may elect to provide us with personal information via E-mail, online registration forms, or our guest book. This information is used internally, as appropriate, to handle the sender's request. It is not disseminated or sold to other organizations.

Some areas of our Website may use a "cookie" temporarily stored on the visitor's computer to allow the web server to log the pages you use within the site and to know if you have visited the site before.
